Key Ingredient

White Soft Paraffin

Ingredients List

White soft paraffin, malt powder, purified water, sugar, soybean oil, cod liver oil, light liquid paraffin, liquid glucose, caramel, sodium CMC, sodium benzoate, methyl paraben, vitamin E acetate, hydroxy propyl methyl cellulose, citric acid monohydrate, butylated hydroxy toluene, propyl paraben, butylated hydroxy anisole.

Actions

Wagg & Purr® Furlax is a complementary aid to manage furballs and mild constipation. Ask your clinic staff if this product is suitable for your cat.

Precautions

Prolonged use may cause certain vitamin deficiencies. Seek advice from your vet if furballs or constipation persist.

Dosage & Administration

For 4 kg cats apply 2 cm of paste from the tube onto the cat's front paw. Cats will ingest the paste whilst grooming. Adjust the amount for smaller and larger cats. See table below for guidance.

| Weight | 2 kg | 4 kg | 6 kg | 8 kg |
|--------|------|------|------|------|
| Dosage | 1 cm | 2 cm | 3 cm | 4 cm |

To aid in the elimination of fur accumulation administer once daily for 2 to 3 days.

To aid in the prevention of fur accumulation during moulting administer once or twice weekly.

To soften faeces in situations of mild faecal retention, administer once daily for 2 to 3 days.
