Cephalexin



Active Constituents

Cephalexin (as monohydrate) 500 mg/tablet, 1000 mg/tablet

Actions

Wagg & Purr® Cephalexin is for the treatment of susceptible bacterial infections.

Indications

Wagg & Purr® Cephalexin is for the treatment of susceptible infections in dogs and cats including:

- · Infections of the skin and localised infections in soft tissues
- · Respiratory tract infections
- · Urogenital tract infections
- · Treatment and prophylaxis of osteomyelitis
- · Treatment of susceptible gastrointestinal tract infections in dogs

Contraindications

This product should not be used in animals that are hypersensitive to cephalosporins and penicillins.

Precautions

Use with caution in cases of known renal insufficiency as accumulation may occur in the kidneys when renal function is impaired. Dose should be reduced.

Side Effects

Some dogs may exhibit nausea and vomiting.

Dosage & Administration

The tablets can be given orally or crushed and added to food.

The dose rate is 10-15 mg/kg bodyweight, twice daily for five days or at the discretion of the veterinary surgeon.

15-24 kg	¼ twice daily
25-50 kg	½-¾ twice daily
51-64 kg	¾-1 twice daily

Tablets (round, cream, quarter-scored), 500 mg, 1000 mg, 100s
