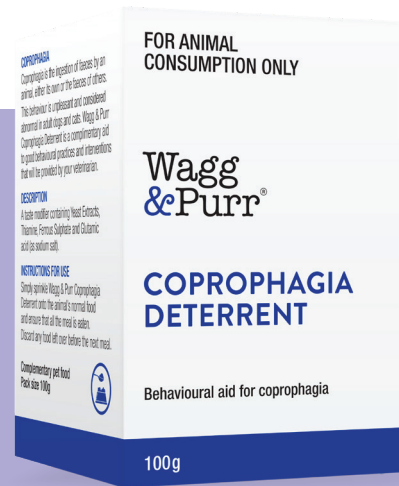

Coprophagia Deterrent



Ingredients

Monosodium glutamate, Brewer's yeast, Ferrous sulphate heptahydrate, and Vitamin B1 (Thiamine HCl)

Analytical Constituents

Crude protein 50.56%

Crude oil 0.31%

Crude fibre 0.20%

Crude ash 0.49%

Nutritional Additives

Compounds of trace elements

Ferrous sulphate heptahydrate 0.09%

Description

Wagg & Purr® Coprophagia Deterrent is a taste modifier containing yeast extracts, thiamine, ferrous sulphate and glutamic acid (as sodium salt).

Uses

Wagg & Purr® Coprophagia Deterrent is a complementary feed to be used as a behavioural aid to help eliminate coprophagia in dogs and cats.

Coprophagia

Coprophagia is the ingestion of faeces by an animal, either its own or the faeces of others. This behaviour can be unpleasant for owners and is considered abnormal in adult dogs and cats. Wagg & Purr® Coprophagia Deterrent is a complementary aid to good behaviour practices and interventions that will be provided by your veterinarian.

Precautions

Please consult your veterinarian BEFORE using Wagg & Purr® Coprophagia Deterrent if your pet is on a controlled or restricted sodium (salt) diet or is receiving a vitamin or iron supplement. Safety in pregnant animals or animals intended for breeding has not been proven. If the condition of the animal worsens, please stop product administration and consult your vet.

This product is for animal use only. Fresh water should always be made available to pets receiving Wagg & Purr® Coprophagia Deterrent.

Dosage & Administration

Simply sprinkle Wagg & Purr® Coprophagia Deterrent onto the animal's normal food and ensure that all the meal is eaten. Discard any food left over before the next meal.

Dogs and cats

One level teaspoon (5 g) per 10 kg of bodyweight per day, divided between each feed for 10-14 days.

Weight	Total daily	Twice a day	Three times a day
5-10 kg	½ tsp	¼ tsp	⅙ tsp
10-20 kg	1 tsp	½ tsp	⅓ tsp
20-30 kg	2 tsp	1 tsp	⅔ tsp

If coprophagia is still exhibited or long-term habit breaking is required Wagg & Purr® Coprophagia Deterrent may be continued for up to 6 weeks.

Very small dogs and cats

In dogs and cats under 5 kg the amount of Wagg & Purr® Coprophagia Deterrent may be difficult to measure. Contact your vet for advice. It is advisable to speak to your veterinary surgeon if your pet is coprophagic to rule out underlying medical conditions that may contribute to coprophagia and to seek general behavioural advice.
