Actions

For the treatment of tapeworm, roundworm, hookworm & whipworm

Indications

For the treatment of:

- Tapeworms (*Dipylidium caninum*, *Taenia ovis*, *T. hydatigena*, *T. pisiformis*) including the Hydatid Tapeworm (*Echinococcus granulosus*),
- Roundworms (*Toxocara canis*, *Toxascaris leonina*),
- Hookworms (*Ancylostoma caninum*, *A. braziliense*, *Uncinaria stenocephala*),
- Whipworms (*Trichuris vulpis*).

Does not control Heartworm (*Dirofilaria immitis*) in dogs.

Dosage & Administration

Weigh your dog to ensure that you give the correct dose and avoid underdosing.

If worm problems persist consult your veterinarian.

The dose rate is 1 tablet per 10 kg.

Do not give to dogs under 1.5 kg bodyweight.

Weight	Tablet Quantity
1.5 – 2.5 kg	¼ tablet
2.6 - 5 kg	½ tablet
5.1 -10 kg	1 tablet
Over 10 kg	1 Tablet per 10 kg*

*Round up to the nearest half or whole tablet

Puppies to 12 weeks of age

Treat at 2, 4, 8 & 12 weeks for:

- Roundworm
- Hookworm

Puppies & Dogs from 12 weeks of age

Treat every 6 weeks for

- Hydatid Tapeworm (Dogs should not be fed or allowed to feed on offal from any species).
- Whipworm

Treat every 3 months for:

- Roundworm
- Hookworm
- Other Tapeworms

Pregnant bitches

- treat at mating and before whelping

General Directions

Your dog needs continual protection from parasites such as worms and fleas, with a regular treatment program. To ensure effective worm control, treat all pets in the household at the same time. Animals infested with worms are a source of re-infestation and may be dangerous to your family. An important part of the worming program is flea control. Dogs are frequently infested by tapeworms (*Dipylidium caninum*) which uses the flea as a carrier.
